ORDINANCE XI

DEGREE BY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS by Statute 13(28) of the Charter of the University the Council is empowered to make ordinances in the exercise of the powers expressly set out in Statute 13 and of all other powers vested in the Council:

AND WHEREAS Article 4(c) of the Charter provides that:

The University shall have the powers to confer distinctions including Honorary Degrees on persons approved by the University provided that such distinctions so conferred shall be conferred and held subject to any provisions which are or may be made in references thereto by the Statutes, Ordinances or Regulations:

AND WHEREAS by Statute 16(10) of the Charter of the University the Senate of the University is empowered to grant distinctions including Honorary Degrees:

THEREFORE the Council of the University hereby ordains as follows:

- the first degree of the University (BA) may be conferred by resolution of the Senate on members of the academic staff or other staff of the University for meritorious service to the University provided that the degree shall not be conferred on a graduate of this or any other University;
- 2) the procedure to be adopted will be that the Honorary Degrees Committee will consider proposals of faculties or other appropriate Units for the award of the Degree by Resolution and make recommendations to the Senate.
