

ORDINANCE I

SENATE MEMBERSHIP OF COUNCIL

Resolved: To approve, on the recommendation of the Senate, the following Temporary Ordinance:

“Ordinance I (1969): For the purposes of the appointment of Senate members to membership of the Council for the period ending 30th June, 1970, the mode of appointment shall be as follows:

The Senate shall elect six members of the academic staff from among those in post on the Appointed Day or expected to be in post by 1st September, 1969, to the membership of the Council, including at least two of non-professorial grade.

The members appointed will hold office for the period to 30th June, 1970, but will be eligible for re-appointment under any revised Ordinance governing the mode of appointment of Senate to membership of the Council.”

Resolved: on the recommendation of the Senate, to approve the following temporary Ordinance; which has the effect of extending the Ordinance governing the period 1969/70:

“The Senate shall elect six members of the academic staff to be membership of the Council, including at least two of non-professorial grade. The members appointed will hold office for the period to 31st July 1971, but will be eligible for reappointment under any revised Ordinance governing the mode of appointment of Senate members to membership of the Council”.
